

**THE SCOTTISH FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE - LOCAL FIRE AND RESCUE

The Plan also aims to support the Argyll and Bute Community Planning Partnership's (CPP) Local Outcomes Improvement Plan (LOIP) 2013-2023 by supporting activities that complement and support the locality planning process.
