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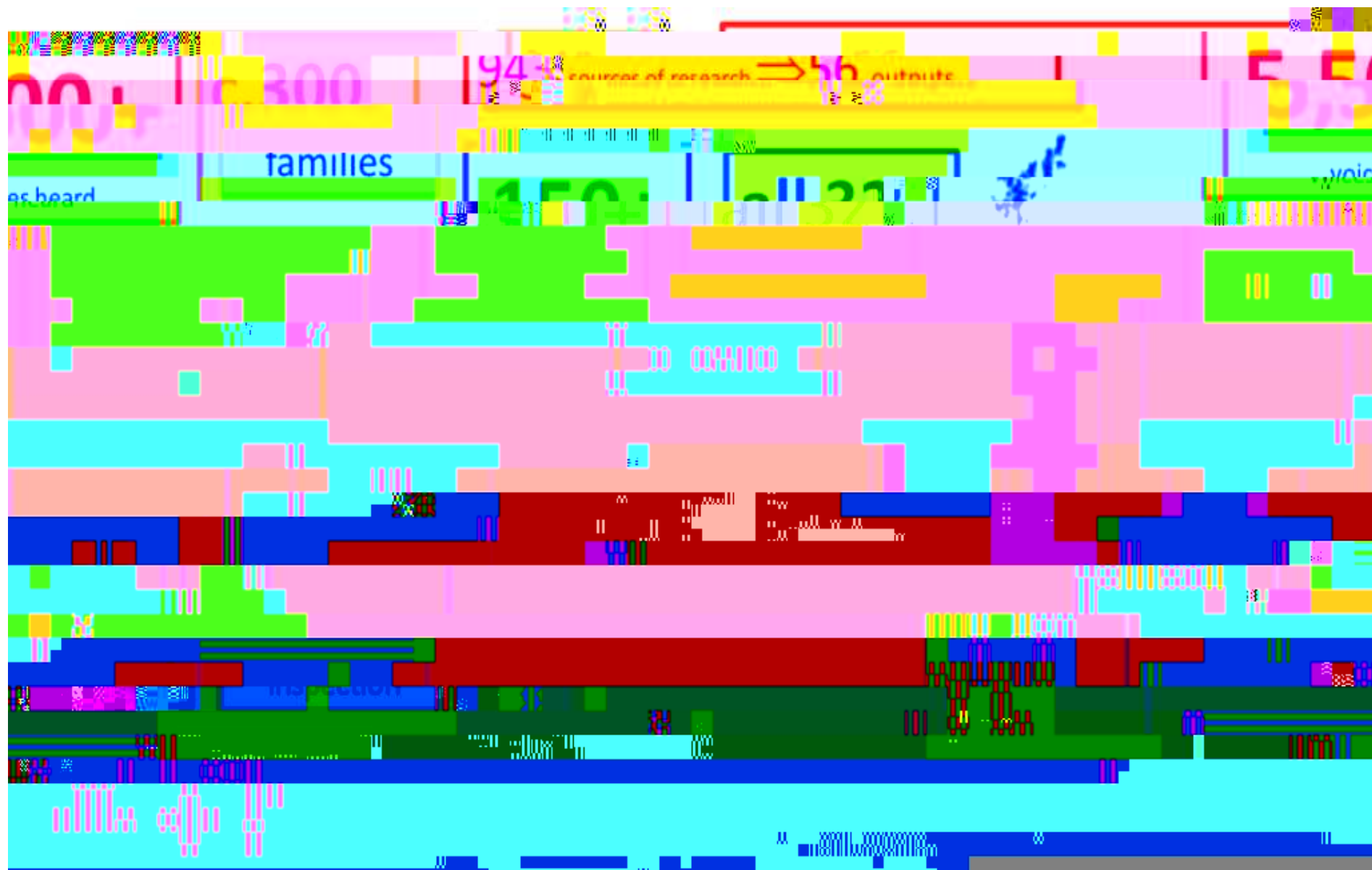
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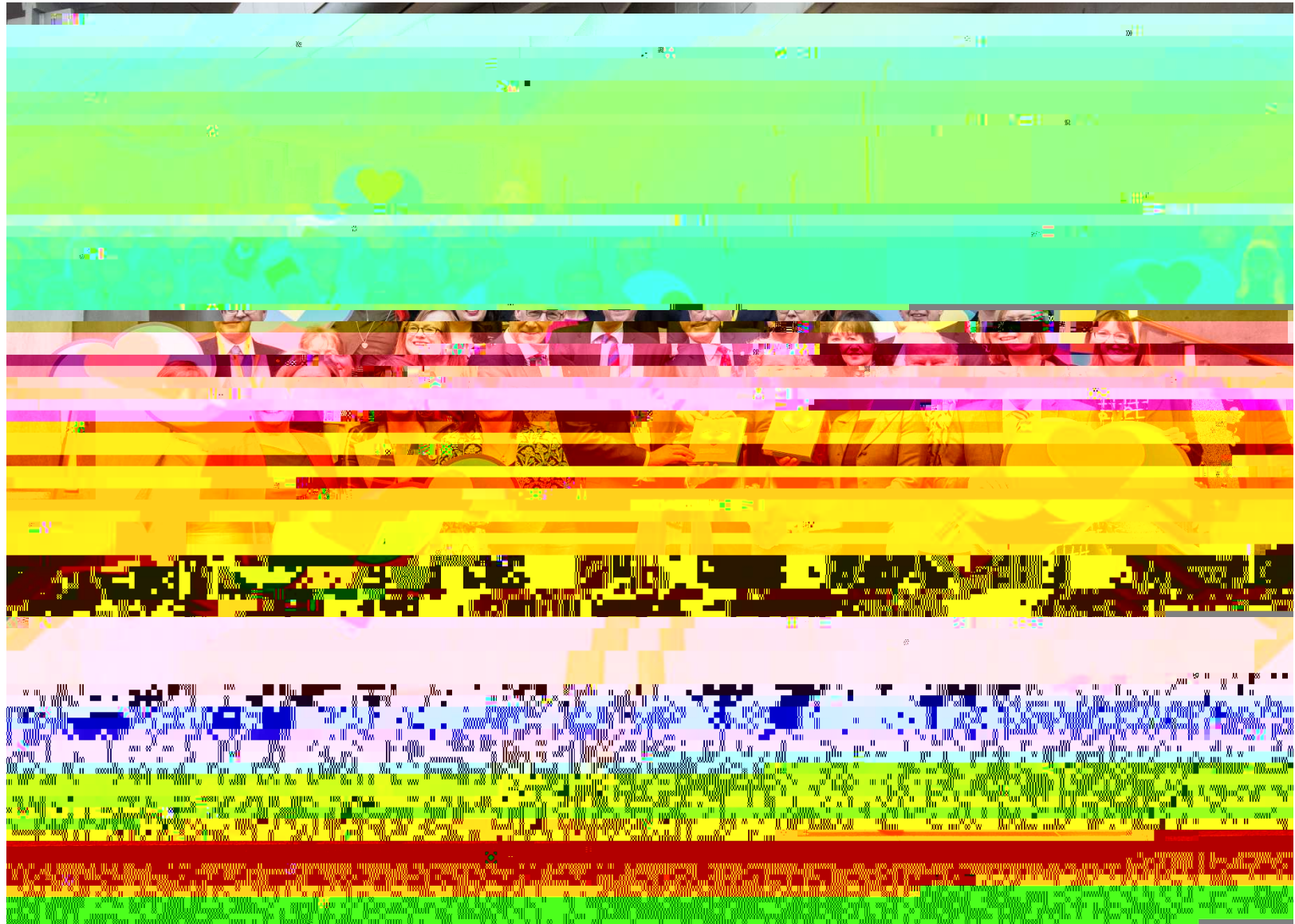

# The Five Foundations of 'the promise'

Family

Voice

Children must be listened to and meaningfully and appropriately involved in decision-making about their care, with all those involved properly listening and responding to what children want and need. This must be a core principle of practice.

Partnership

Children should not routinely be taken away from their families and placed in care where care is needed. Children should be supported to stay with their families and carers where care is needed.

Scaffolding

Children, families and the workforce must be supported by a system that is there when it is needed. The scaffolding of help, support and accountability must be ready and responsive when it is required.
