Subsequent to previous calls for funding contributions, we had two firm contributions from partners:

£20,000NHS Highland - Argyll & Bute Health and Social Care Partnership£50,000Argyll and Bute Council

We also recently received funding from NatureScot to the tune of £7,000 for this

£15,000.

4.2 Next Steps

The Climate Change working Group have decided to start the project with the budget we currently have.

We have decided that we would advertise the Project Manager post with options for:

- i) 0.75 Full Time Equivalent for two years, or
- ii) 1.0 Full Time Equivalent for 18 months

In any case we would need to continue searching for funding for either a continuation of the project timeline, or to provide additional assistance for the part time setup. However, it was felt that finding £30,000 in year two would be achievable.

Given this decision and approach, we are currently finalising the legal agreements
